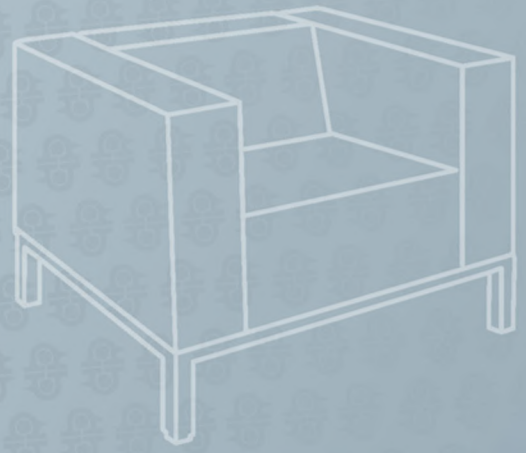

#### FINDING PURPOSE & SUCCESS

Preparing for life after prison, Alan worked over a decade for PRIDE Enterprises, progressing from Data Entry Operator to Full-Stack .NET Developer while earning more than 20 professional certifications from Microsoft and the Department of Education.

Upon release, his first objective was employment. Within six weeks, he secured a Senior Software Developer role with a major consulting firm.

Today, Alan is grateful for his current "set of problems," the ability to make his own choices, and the opportunity to be a living example of the power of second chances. He advocates for human dignity, questions the status quo, and believes everyone deserves access to the tools they need to thrive.

He is a staunch supporter of PRIDE's mission: inmates aren't hired to make products; products are made to hire inmates. He often says the most important shift in his life came when he was finally seen as a person, not an inmate.

Alan brings a sharpened perspective to every business he touches, emphasizing communication, equity, and using the right tool for the right job. He challenges recruiters and employers to move beyond checkbox hiring and recognize candidates as people, not just placements.

#### GROWING UP IN PRISON

Seeking to give back even while inside, he served as a Chapel Clerk and Head Encourager in a Faith and Character-Based Dorm, sharing the lessons others had poured into him.

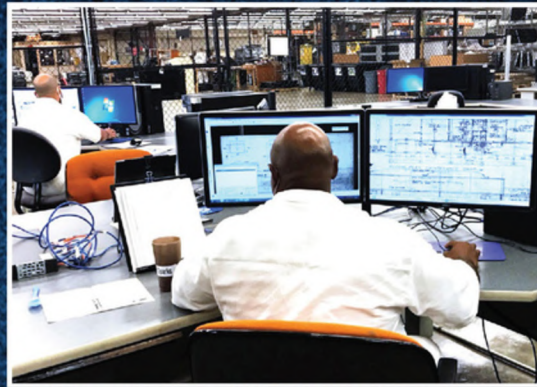

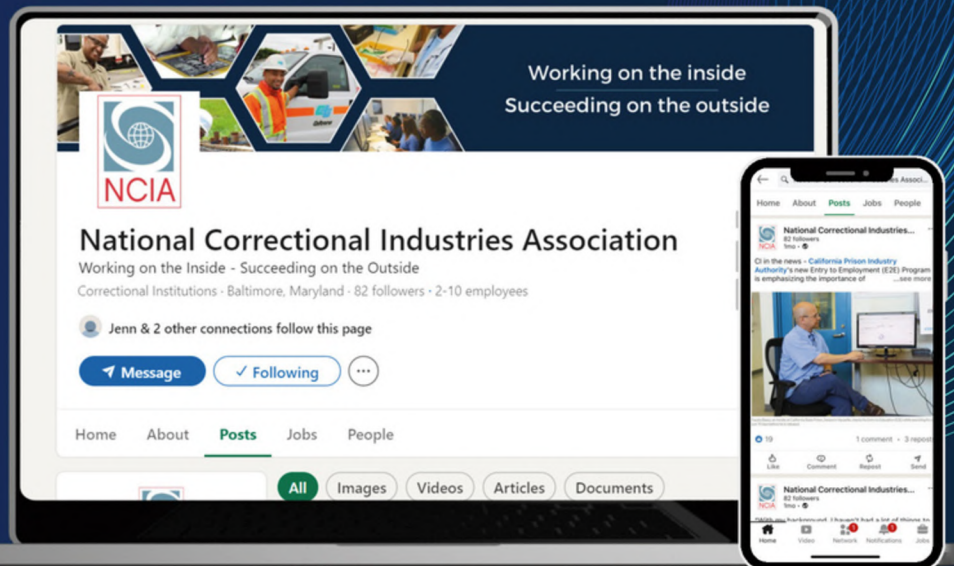
